Try making one in your yard, or sidewalk.</p> 	<p>Plant flowers for bees Bees play an important part in helping make some of our favorite fruits and foods. Learn more here. Plant flowers in a DIY pot or in the garden.</p>	<p>Recycle materials airplane challenge Use some of your old school work and try making a paper airplane. Test them outside. Try a helicopter. What other materials can you make fly?</p>	<p>Paint with mud Mix some dirt and water together and paint "mud pictures" on paper or on the sidewalk with your fingers. Try making a nature paintbrush.</p>
<p>Pick some dandelions Make naturally yellow playdough. Try dandelion muffins, shortbread, or iced tea</p> 	<p>Nature bookmark Use laminating sheets, Mac Tac, or packing tape to make a nature bookmark.</p> 	<p>Get lost Go somewhere new and explore. Maybe get off the path and find some new plants. Try different city or provincial parks. Watch out for poison ivy.</p>	<p>Make a wind chime You can use a lot of recycled materials to make a creative wind chime. See this list for inspiration!</p>
